



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR GRANT APPLICATIONS: PRIORITY GRANTS

All grants will be reviewed based on the following criteria. The numbers in brackets indicate the total points that can be awarded for each area. Clearly indicate the objective(s) your application addresses.

1. Does the program address the priorities as set out by UWCI? [10]
2. Does the proposal demonstrate need, using existing data, wait lists, research, letters of support?[10]
3. What is the capacity of the applicant and the people involved in implementation or service delivery in terms of experience, education, resources and abilities? [10]
4. What will the impact to the community be in the short and long term? [10]
5. What are the programs measurable and achievable outcomes?[15]
6. What evaluation or monitoring processes will be put in place to measure performance against the measurable benefits or outcomes identified in the proposal? [15]
7. Are the budget and related activities realistic to the program described? [10]
8. Does the program provide good value with respect to UWCI's contribution?(e.g. makes use of other funding sources and/or operated in a cost efficient manner) [10]
9. How is the proposal different than other services in the community? [10]
10. What is the involvement of volunteers in the delivery of the program? [10]
11. Does the proposal leverage other funding, including but not restricted to utilization of existing funding and in-kind contributions? [10]
12. Does the proposal involve other community partners and if so, how are they involved? [15]
13. Have partners provided a letter delineating their contribution? [5]
